

# Anticipated SEVIS Release 4.11 System Changes

As of April 28, 2004

Planned Release Date: May 22, 2004

**NOTE: The installation of all anticipated system changes identified in this document is dependent on successful completion of testing.**

**The following highlights the functionality proposed for this release:**

## ***All Users: SEVIS Fee Payment Information***

- SEVIS is being adapted to collect information on the SEVIS fee payments and/or cancellation of fee payments by students and exchange visitors. The “I-901 Fee Payment Information” fields now available on the student and exchange visitor detail screen will be updated to include the “Receipt Number.” The SEVIS fee information will be included in the data transmitted to the Department of State’s Bureau of Consular Affairs’ Consolidated Consular Database (CCD).

## ***Batch Users***

- SEVIS nightly maintenance jobs will now recognize and process a termination or completion date (current, future and/or past) for an exchange visitor via batch. For example, a sponsor can submit a termination or completion date that is today’s date or a date prior to today’s date (a date in the past) and when the nightly maintenance job runs, it will recognize today’s date or a date prior to today’s date. Termination or completion dates that are submitted with a future date will be processed when that future date becomes the current date (i.e., a termination/completion date submitted for August 1, 2004 will be processed by the SEVIS nightly maintenance job on August 1 (not before).
- Schools with multiple records with the same SEVIS ID at the same campus (e.g., a deactivated/completed and an initial/active record for a student) will be able to update the initial/active records using the Batch interface.

## ***F/M School Users***

- The correct Program End Date will print on the I-20 when an extension or shorten program is requested for a student.
