Immigration Fugitives - Latest Processing Disposition Code before departure is Bag and Baggage (B) OR Case Category at time of Latest Arrest was Fugitive (8E, 8I, 5B). $Repeat\ Immigration\ Violators-Anyone\ with\ prior\ departure\ or\ prior\ voluntary\ return.$

Recent Border Entrants - Removals initiated by CBP at or near Border. Based on Latest Program Code before departure that is Border Patrol (BP) or Inspections (ISA, ISL, ISS, ISP), Latest Apprehension Method Code before departure that is Inspections (ISP) or Patrol Border (PB), Case Category of 8F, 8G or 8H associated with the Removal case, or an Entry Date within three years of Departed Date.

Other Removable Aliens - This category includes those aliens who entered unlawfully or entered lawfully and violated conditions of admission; aliens who may also fall into the above priorities but cannot be verified in the data available to ICE (i.e. criminals with no

Data used to report on ICE statistics are obtained through the ICE Integrated Decision Support (IIDS) system data warehouse. The records in this system are refreshed on a daily basis, and typically effect any updates to an alien's case as new information becomes available to ICE. Data obtained from this system will reflect the status of these records as of the date the data is retrieved. Any records that have yet to be administratively updated in the IIDS warehouse will not be reflected in the data reported. The information retrieved from the IIDS warehouse changes on a daily basis, due to the dynamic nature of the process of updating records.
