
and food you must have your wristband correctly worn; otherwise you will not be allowed to purchase items from the commissary store.

Occasionally, you may wish to receive funds from your family or friends. There are three ways to receive funds via internet, telephone, and authorized money order.

## Internet and Phone:

Your family and friends can deposit funds via Keefe Detainee Trust Account at <a href="www.inmatdeposits.com/1-866-345-1884">www.inmatdeposits.com/1-866-345-1884</a> or Talton Pre-Paid Phone Services at <a href="www.taltoncommunications.com/1-866-516-0115">www.taltoncommunications.com/1-866-516-0115</a> and follow the instruction on the website or the phone operator to register for an account. Once family or friends have registered for an account they can use your name and A-number to locate your account and deposit funds. Below is a diagram explaining the differences of the above accounts:




The Keefe Trust account, you can buy at the Commissary Store AND make detainee telephone calls.

## INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO USE THE KEEFE TRUST ACCOUNT TO PAY FOR THE PHONE SYSTEM

- 1. Enter your assigned PIN code.
- 2. Enter the phone number you would like to call.
- 3. At this point an additional voice prompt will play stating, "If you would like to use your trust account to pay for this call, press 1".
  - The call will be connected if the detainee has enough money in their trust account.

 If the detainee does not have money in their trust account, the following message will be played, "Your trust account cannot be used".



The Talton prepaid phone account, you can only make detainee telephone calls.

## Money Orders:

Only **U.S. Postal Service Money Orders** will be accepted. Money orders must be made out to ICE with your full name and complete Alien-Number at the bottom of the money order. Any other money order or an incorrectly completed money order will be returned to sender. You are cautioned not to have cash sent to you in the mail. Any cash received will also be returned to sender. An example of correctly completed money is posted in each housing unit.

If you have an attorney and need to withdraw money from your detainee trust account to pay for legal services you will need to fill out an Emergency Request form, located in your housing area. Once you have completed the form you will hand it over to your housing officer who will in turn forward the request to the supervisor for approval or denial. If the request is approved you will be notified of the appointment period in order for you to contact your attorney with the information. Please be aware that all appointments will be scheduled for Monday thru Friday from 7:00am to 3:00pm.
