### Facility Snapshot/Description

The Christian County Jail is owned by Christian County and operated by the Christian County Sheriff's Office. The jail is located in Ozark, Missouri, approximately twenty miles south of Springfield, Missouri. The facility houses adult male and female ICE, Christian County, U.S. Marshals Service and state of Missouri detainees.

According to the administrative lieutenant, the physical plant consists of a podular remote jail design with six housing units. The units are a combination of dormitories and two-person cells.

[REDACTED] The overflow inmates sleep on cots or plastic "boat" beds. All ICE detainees were assigned to a bunk during the inspection. ICE detainees are housed with detainees from other jurisdictions based on classification levels.

Photo images depicted a roll-up door that is opened for outdoor recreation to permit fresh air and access to light. The dayroom is furnished with televisions, telephones, board games and kiosks. Due to COVID-19 restrictions, all visitation is conducted remotely via video.

No detainees volunteered to speak with the inspectors. According to the administrative lieutenant, the detainees were verbally asked in English and Spanish.

Advanced Correctional Healthcare provides medical services. Tiger Correctional Services provides food services. All other services are provided by Christian County employees. ICE detainees do not incur medical co-payments.
