Comments: The Sexual Abuse and Assault Prevention and Intervention Standard (SAAPI) was inspected during this inspection but is not referenced in the Detention Standards Review Summary Report. The Standard was rated as Meets Standard for this inspection.

There were no allegations of sexual assault or abuse involving an ICE detainee during the inspection period.

There were no escapes, deaths or serious suicide attempts during the inspection period. Canines may be used for contraband detection but never in the presence of ICE detainees. OC (oleoresin capsicum)/pepper spray is the only chemical agent used by the facility. The use of unsafe types of force such as choke holds, carotid control holds and neck restraints are not authorized. Tasers are not used.

There were no uses of force involving an ICE detainee during the inspection period.
