Comments: The information provided on the Significant Incident Summary Worksheet refers to ICE detainee incidents. The facility was unable to provide the information for section M. Average Daily Population. The Sexual Abuse and Assault Prevention and Intervention PBNDS 2011 Standard was inspected during this inspection but is not referenced in the Standards Review Summary Report. The Standard was rated Meets Standard for this inspection.

At-Risk

There were three allegations of sexual assault or abuse during the inspection period involving ICE detainees. Two allegations were for inappropriate touching, and one allegation was for inappropriate sexual comments and assault. All three allegations involved detainee against detainee and all investigation findings were unsubstantiated. Documentation of facility policy and practice were reviewed and confirmed to be within the guidelines of the standards. Available video footage was reviewed during the investigation.

During the inspection period, there were four use of force incidents involving ICE detainees. All four incidents involved immediate uses of force. Three cases involved detainee on detainee fights in which verbal orders were ignored and responding staff used OC and/or physical force to contain the incident and gain control of the detainees. The fourth incident involved a detainee acting in an agitated manner and refusing staff orders to submit to being handcuffed. Physical force was used to control the detainee and apply handcuffs. In all four cases medical attention was prompt and other than OC exposure in two incidents, no injuries were reported. The written reports fully documented the incidents and the force used in all four incidents was appropriate for the circumstances. The afteraction reviews conducted by supervisors and managers were completed in accordance with policy.

The use of choke holds, carotid control holds and/or neck restraints are not authorized. The facility does not use Tasers. The facility authorizes the use of OC (oleoresin capsicum). The facility does not have a canine unit and does not use canines for contraband detection. There were no escapes, escape attempts, suicides or serious suicide attempts during the inspection period.
