

Comments: The Sexual Abuse and Assault Prevention and Intervention Standard was inspected during this inspection but is not referenced in the Standards Review Summary Report. The Standard was rated as Meets Standard for this inspection.

There were three allegations of sexual assault or abuse involving an ICE detainee during this inspection period. All of the allegations were detainee-on-detainee. One allegation was between two male detainees and two allegations involved female detainees. The alleged behaviors ranged from inappropriate touching to flashing breasts in an attempt to engage in a sexual act. Two allegations were determined to be unsubstantiated and one unfounded. None of the allegations involved oral, anal or vaginal penetration or attempted penetration. All the case files were reviewed and procedures conducted by medical and detention staff comply with the requirements of the standard.

There were no escapes, deaths or serious suicide attempts during the inspection period. The facility does not have a canine unit for contraband detection. The only chemical agent in the facility is OC (oleoresin capsicum)/pepper spray. The use of unsafe types of force such as choke holds, carotid control holds and neck restraints are not authorized. Tasers are not used.

There were four calculated uses of force reported during the previous twelve months; two on 12/14/2017 and two on 12/27/2017. On each date, two Cuban detainees refused to move from their assigned beds when ordered to pack their property and walk to the

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receiving and discharge area for deportation. Subsequent to a supervisor ordering each detainee to move, the detainee passively refused by staying on his assigned bed. Officers picked up each detainee by his arms, legs and torso, moved him to a wheel chair and rolled him to a holding room in the receiving and discharge area where the detainee was placed on the floor and evaluated by a nurse for injuries. The use of force was concluded after the medical evaluation. No injuries were sustained by either staff or detainees. Each use of force was documented, recorded via audio-visual video and an after-action review was conducted.

The reported use of a weapon during an offender on offender assault as indicated on the Significant Incident Summary Worksheet was a plastic dayroom chair thrown at a detainee during a fight. No injuries were sustained.
