Facility Snapshot/Description

This inspection was conducted remotely due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Observations were conducted via a review of photographs and/or videos. Interviews were conducted via telephone. The Saint Clair County Jail located in Port Huron, Michigan is owned by Saint Clair County and is operated under the jurisdiction of the Saint Clair County Sheriff's Department. The direct supervision facility houses all custody levels of male and female detainees for ICE, the U. S. Marshals Service, the Federal Bureau of Prisons, Michigan Department of Corrections and local jurisdictions.

ICE detainees are housed with other populations of similar custody levels. With the exception of the dedicated segregation management units, all housing units consist of dormitory style beds. The housing units contain a large dayroom area with tables and chairs. Detainees have access to various board and card games. Televisions are available in the living and sleeping areas but not in the dayrooms. Detainees are able to watch movies on the tablets available in the housing units. Detainees are able to visit with family and friends via video visitation either onsite or remotely. An outdoor recreation area is adjacent to each housing unit and is available seven days a week.

No less than fifteen detainee interviews were conducted over the telephone. The telephonic translation line was used to conduct interviews of LEP detainees from Ecuador, Guatemala, and India. Generally, there were no substantive concerns. All of the detainees stated they felt safe at the facility. Detainees voiced no complaints regarding sanitation and generally rated the sanitation as average or above average. All of the detainees interviewed were complimentary of the food provided in both quantity and quality.

The facility does not charge ICE detainees co-pays for medical, mental health or dental care. Food service is provided by Aramark and medical services are provided by Corizon. All other services are provided by Saint Clair County employees.

Areas of Concern/Significant Observations

There were no areas of concern or significant observations noted during the inspection.

Recommended Rating and Justification

The Lead Compliance Inspector recommends that the facility receive a rating of Meets Standard unless unobserved practices and conditions are contrary to what was reported to the inspection team. The facili-



ty complies with the ICE Performance Based National Detention Standards (PBNDS 2008). No (0) standards were found Does Not Meet Standard and two (2) standards were Not Applicable (N/A). All remaining thirty-nine (39) standards were found to Meet Standard
