



DIRECTIVE TITLE: National Infrastructure Protection Plan Government Facilities Sector

1. PURPOSE and SCOPE. This Directive establishes U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) policy for compliance with the National Infrastructure Protection Plan (NIPP) and directs specific personnel at the Federal Protective Service (FPS) to perform requisite tasks. Its scope is limited to the responsibilities of ICE/FPS as the designated Department of Homeland Security (DHS) component for the Government Facilities Sector, as defined in the NIPP.
