#### **Protestors**

- Protestors dispersed at approximately 3am on 13 June 2025.
- Protesters were blocking the gate as vehicles were going in and out. One protester slashed the tire of an FBI vehicle coming into gate.
- Newark PD came but did not assist with protestors.

- Per GEO, Central Control did not report/notice the escape from (b)(7)(E) in yard.
- No exterior perimeter GEO officer was monitoring the second/outer gate leading to the street.
- No GEO officer on the unit alerted ICE staff on-site of any escape attempt.
- GEO advised ERO approximately 10pm that breakfast meal had been delayed 4 hours;
   GEO stated the delay was due to a large number of detainees that had to be outprocessed for removal/transfer.
- GEO detainee roster was not accurate requiring ICE to conduct face-to-face to account for all detainees in the facility.
