INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury Charges:

Count One
Production of Child Pornography
(Violation of 18 U.S.C. § 2251(a))

On or about April 23, 2014, in the Fort Worth Division of the Northern District of Texas, and elsewhere, defendant **Gregory Bogomol** did knowingly use, persuade, induce, entice, and coerce a minor, "MV11," to engage in sexually explicit conduct for the purpose of producing any visual depiction of such conduct, and knowing and having reason to know that such visual depiction would be transported and transmitted using any means and facility of interstate and foreign commerce.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. § 2251(a).

Count Two

Production of Child Pornography
(Violation of 18 U.S.C. § 2251(a))

On or about April 20, 2014, in the Fort Worth Division of the Northern District of Texas, and elsewhere, defendant **Gregory Bogomol** did knowingly use, persuade, induce, entice, and coerce a minor, "MV13," to engage in sexually explicit conduct for the purpose of producing any visual depiction of such conduct, and knowing and having reason to know that such visual depiction would be transported and transmitted using any means and facility of interstate and foreign commerce.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. § 2251(a).

Forfeiture Notice
(18 U.S.C. § 2253)

Upon conviction of either offense alleged in Count One and Count Two and pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 2253(a), defendant **Bogomol** shall forfeit to the United States (a) any visual depiction described in 18 U.S.C. § 2251 and 18 U.S.C. § 2252, and any book, magazine, periodical, film, videotape, or other matter which contains any such visual depiction, which was produced, transported, mailed, shipped, or received in the respective offense; (b) any property, real or personal, constituting or traceable to gross profits or other proceeds obtained from the respective offense; and (c) any property, real or personal, used or intended to be used to commit or to promote the commission of the respective offense and any property traceable to such property.

The above-referenced property subject to forfeiture from the defendant includes, but is not limited to, any interest in the following:

1. One Samsung Galaxy phone, serial number R31D90ZHA4H, taken from **Bogomol** on May 6, 2014, in Fort Worth, Texas, by Homeland Security Investigation agents.


