- The U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) Office of Congressional Relations (OCR) began tracking of private immigration bill statistics with the 110<sup>th</sup> Congress.
- Private immigration relief legislation (and associated requests for reports) may cover multiple individuals.
- As of May 5, 2017, the ICE policy regarding stays of removal in conjunction with private immigration relief legislation states:
  - ICE will consider and issue a stay of removal only if the Chair of the full Committee or Subcommittee expressly makes a written request that ICE stay the beneficiary’s removal independent of any request for investigative report; a request for an investigative report will not trigger an automatic stay of removal.
  - ICE will not grant a beneficiary more than one stay of removal through the private immigration bill process. As such, ICE will not honor subsequent requests for a stay of removal from the Chair of the Committee or Subcommittee for beneficiaries who have already received a stay through the private immigration bill process.
  - If granted, the duration of a stay of removal is limited to not more than six months. However, the ICE Director, at his or her discretion, may provide a one-time, 90-day extension beyond the initial stay of removal if requested by the Chair of the Committee or Subcommittee to accommodate extenuating circumstances.
