Form	Document Title	Description	Information
I-515A	Notice to Student or Exchange Visitor	This form is issued to a nonimmigrant student, exchange visitor or their dependents that arrive at a port of entry without required documentation. This document authorizes entry into the US for thirty days while the nonimmigrant collects and submits the necessary documentation.	<a href="#">I-515 Toolkit</a>
I-17	Petition for Approval of School for Attendance by Nonimmigrant Student	This form and its supplements are used by a school or school system to request approval from SEVP to admit nonimmigrant students.	<a href="#">I-17 Frequently Asked Questions</a>
I-20	Certificate of Eligibility for Nonimmigrant Student Status	This form is issued by an SEVP-certified school to a prospective nonimmigrant student. The form is used to pay the SEVIS I-901 fee and is presented at the visa interview and/or at the U.S. port of entry. I-901	Fee Remittance for Certain F, J and M Nonimmigrants	This required fee supports the Student and Exchange Visitor Program.	<a href="#">SEVIS I-901 Fee Web site</a>

I-765	Application for Employment Authorization	This application is filed by nonimmigrant students to receive authorization for certain types of employment.	<a href="#">USCIS Web site</a>
I-539	Application to Extend/Change Nonimmigrant Status	This form is used by some nonimmigrants to request extensions of stay or changes from one nonimmigrant category to another nonimmigrant category.
