SEVIS Release 6.83 will match SEVIS Batch functionality to:

- SEVIS Release 6.82.1: In accordance with Executive Order 14168, Defending Women from Gender Ideology, Extremism and Restoring Biological Truth to the Federal Government:
 - All SEVIS data fields labeled Gender will change to Sex.
 - The Other option will not be available for the Sex data field when creating or updating an Initial F/M student, Exchange Visitor or dependent SEVIS record.
- SEVIS Release 6.82.2: SEVIS F/M Batch functionality will update the following fields on the Disciplinary Action page:
 - Explanation of Disciplinary Action Taken:
 - Adds 1000-character limit countdown to open text field.
 - Makes comments appear on the Form I-20, "Certificate of Eligibility for Nonimmigrant Student Status."
 - Was this disciplinary action taken as the result of the conviction of a crime:
 - Changes response options to Yes or No radio buttons.
 - Changes to a Required field.
