### Student Resources on *Study in the States*

Have you told your students about [Study in the States](#)? The site has many resources for prospective and current F and M students. Some of the resources include a school search page to find Student and Exchange Visitor Program (SEVP)-certified schools, information on applying for visas through the U.S. Department of State and guidelines for working in the United States. Encourage prospective students to visit the site to learn how to prepare for their journeys to the United States. You can direct current students to visit the site to learn about processes, such as how to obtain a Social Security number or a driver's license. *Study in the States* provides numerous resources for students and is now available in 64 languages.

### Update on the I-901 SEVIS Fee

Regulations require all prospective F and M students to pay the I-901 Student and Exchange Visitor Information System (SEVIS) fee before the U.S. Department of State will issue them a visa. Beginning Aug. 4, F and M students will no longer receive a mailed receipt after paying their I-901 SEVIS fee. Instead, they will need to print the receipt themselves from the [FMJfee](#) website. The printable payment confirmation will replace the I-797C, "Notice of Action," mailed receipt. The student can print the payment confirmation after completing a payment or by clicking on the "Check Status" button on the FMJfee website and entering the student's SEVIS identification, name and date of birth.
