INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury Charges:

Count One

Attempted Sex Trafficking of a Child
(Violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1594(a), 1591(a)(1), and 18 U.S.C. § 2)

On or about December 31, 2014, in the Amarillo Division of the Northern District of Texas, and elsewhere, **Xzavion Dayshaun Ragsdale**, also known as "Yung Billy," defendant, knowingly attempted to recruit, entice, harbor, transport, provide, obtain, and maintain by any means, in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce, "J.B.," knowing, and in reckless disregard of the fact, that "J.B." had not attained the age of 18 years and would be caused to engage in a commercial sex act.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 1594(a), 1591(a)(1), and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

Count Two
Attempted Sex Trafficking of a Child
(Violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1594(a), 1591(a)(1), and 18 U.S.C. § 2)

From on or about March 30, 2015, through on or about April 3, 2015, in the Amarillo Division of the Northern District of Texas, and elsewhere, **Xzavion Dayshaun Ragsdale**, also known as “Yung Billy,” defendant, knowingly attempted to recruit, entice, harbor, transport, provide, obtain, and maintain by any means, in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce, "A.M.," knowing, and in reckless disregard of the fact, that "A.M." had not attained the age of 18 years and would be caused to engage in a commercial sex act.


All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 1594(a), 1591(a)(1), and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

Count Three
Attempted Transfer of Obscene Material to a Minor
(Violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1470)

On or about March 30, 2015, in the Amarillo Division of the Northern District of Texas, and elsewhere, **Xzavion Dayshaun Ragsdale**, also known as “Yung Billy,” defendant, did, by a facility and means of interstate and foreign commerce, to wit: a cellular telephone and the internet, knowingly attempt to transfer obscene matter to another individual who had not attained the age of 16 years, knowing that such other individual had not attained the age of 16 years.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1470.




