General Information

The Student and Exchange Visitor Program (SEVP) is always looking for ways to improve current processes based on stakeholder needs and concerns. Over the last few months, we have received feedback from several SEVP field representatives regarding the increased number of broadcast messages distributed on a monthly basis. In response, SEVP identified a solution that will reduce the influx of messages Student and Exchange Visitor Information System (SEVIS) users receive via email.

Starting on May 16, 2016, SEVP will only send the following messages via email:

- Emergency and time-sensitive messages
- Batch-related messages

SEVP will continue to post all other messages to the SEVIS message board and to the <u>ICE.gov</u> <u>Broadcast Message archive page</u> for SEVIS users to view at their discretion. Please click on the Broadcast Message tab in the gray header section on the ICE.gov What's New page to locate the Broadcast Message archive page.

Moving forward, SEVP will distribute a "broadcast message recap" on a biweekly basis as a reminder to check the SEVIS message board for the latest messages. The recap will also provide a brief description of the non-emergency messages posted to the SEVIS message board during the two-week period.

Note: Schools and school officials are responsible for information contained in messages from SEVP and the U.S. Department of State, regardless of whether the information is sent via email or posted directly to the message board.

SEVP will provide updates in the coming months about additional improvements being made to the broadcast message functionality in SEVIS.
