INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury Charges:

Count One
Bank Robbery
(Violation of 18 U.S.C. § 2113(a))

On or about November 20, 2017, in the Lubbock Division of the Northern District of Texas, and elsewhere, **Eddie Estuardo Galindo-Mendez**, defendant, by force and violence, and by intimidation, did intentionally take from the person and presence of another, that is, employees of Happy State Bank, 4402 19th Street, Lubbock, Texas, money, that is, United States currency, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of said Happy State Bank, a bank whose deposits were then insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.


