Jennifer Cleary is the Chief Financial Officer for U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement. Ms. Cleary leads a team of 350 personnel, including three subordinate Senior Executives, and is responsible for budgetary, accounting, and financial oversight for the agency's \$8 billion budget, and serves as the liaison for Congressional Appropriations engagement.



Prior to this role, Ms. Cleary was the Assistant Director

for Homeland Security Investigation's (HSI) Office of Administrative Operations (OAO). In this capacity, Ms. Cleary strategically oversaw HSI's budgetary, human resource and asset management functions, supporting the efficient execution of HSI's resources for over 10,000 employees across roughly 220 offices throughout the United States and worldwide. Ms. Cleary held several leadership positions in Administrative Operations, including the Deputy Assistant Director position, gaining expertise in budget execution and formulation, financial management, procurement and acquisition planning, facilities, fleet and property management, human resources management, policy, information disclosure, records management, and strategic planning.

In 2018, Ms. Cleary served as the Acting Deputy CFO for ICE, providing strategic oversight to the CFO office. Ms. Cleary began her federal career with the U.S. Treasury Department holding various budgetary, financial management and auditing positions with the Financial Management Service, Office of the Inspector General and the U.S. Customs Service. In 2003, Ms. Cleary joined Immigration and Customs Enforcement serving in key supervisory positions in both HSI and the Office of Professional Responsibility. Ms. Cleary holds a bachelor's degree in business administration from James Madison University and is a Certified Public Accountant in the State of Maryland.
